

Fond du Lac Soccer Association
11/28/07 Board of Directors Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Fond du Lac Soccer Association Board of Directors was held on Wednesday, November 28, 2007 at 7:00 pm at the Fond du Lac City Government Building in Room F. The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer were present. The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved as corrected.

The report of the Treasurer was received and approved.

The East Central Soccer Report was given by Mr. Don Wirtz.

Mr. Greg Winkler led a discussion on Fond du Lac Soccer Recreation League registration. Rosters will be created in relation to the school that the youth attends. Formatting of the registration form was also discussed. The registration form will be placed on the Fond du Lac Soccer website and distributed to all of the youth in the Fond du Lac Schools.

Mr. Mike Kobilic indicated that the UW-FDL Contract was signed and dropped off for John Kiefer. Mr. Kobilic will await any further updates.

The new business of the U16/U19 Recreation League Teams playing on a co-ed basis was addressed. Discussion focused on the preferences of the players and the format of the games. Game nights and advertising were also considered and the format of the registration form was addressed.

Walk-In Registration for Rec. League players will be held on January 8th and 22nd from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm at Woodworth Middle School. Play It Again Sports will be there on January 8th and will sponsor at least 1 team and give out \$5 gift cards to players.

Mr. Winkler moved that "The Fond du Lac Soccer Association purchase 1200 trophies for rec. league players." After consideration was given to the specific trophy to purchase and further debate, the motion was adopted as follows: "The Fond du Lac Soccer Association will purchase 1200-3" youth trophies for the recreational league at a cost of \$2.50 each."

Other new business that was considered was the gifts for coaches this season. Typically \$10 was spent for each coach. Gifts in the past included a coaching shirt or bag. Other suggestions included coaching materials.

Ms. Ange Schneider proposed that travel teams (through the Levi Group) run food/beverages at Packer Games. They would receive 45 dollars per person for up to 10 people. Two teams would need to volunteer for every home game. Volunteers must be parents, not players. The FDL Soccer Association would need to commitment for next

season-11 games total (8 season and 3 preseason). The item was tabled and will be considered further at the January Fond du Lac Soccer Association Board Meeting.

Mr. Wirtz reported on the current status of referee classes.

Mr. Wirtz also reported that he had cleaned up the concession stand and took the remaining soda to Eden Stone who paid \$15 per case.

Mr. Winkler discussed insurance for the recreation league players. Security Life offers a policy that would be effective from May to August at \$2.50 per player.

Other discussion focused on how to promote increased use of the Fond du Lac Soccer Complex. Mr. Winkler is working on a High School All Star Game Possibility.

The Christmas party is on the 8th of December at Backyard Grill – 7:00 pm

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
